Arizona

Wild Horse Pass Resort & Spa Chandler, Arizona, 15 min. from Phoenix

As Bird Golf's West Coast flagship site, we are proud to be the official golf school of the Wild Horse Pass Resort and Spa. Wild Horse Pass has already taken its place as one of the finest golf resort destinations in the Southwest. Wild Horse Pass is nestled between the Sierra Estrella and South Mountains and is an easy 15 minute drive from Phoenix airport. You will enjoy the rugged, awe-inspiring vistas surrounding the resort and the golf courses. With every conceivable amenity, Wild Horse has something for everybody. The perfect Arizona resort setting.

The resort has been the recipient of several awards. Recognized by the Zagat survey 2005, as one of America's Best Resorts and featured in Travel and Leisure magazine (January 2005) as one of the world's most enriching, culturally authentic resorts, Wild Horse is not just another resort, but an experience. 




Arizona

Classic Club Palm Springs, California, 1.5 hours from L.A.



Water comes into play on 6 holes, and you need to employ strategy rather than force to play your way through the stunning scenery that constantly surrounds you. Located right in the heart of the town of Pinehurst, the Inn and its staff take great pride in giving you the best in gracious Southern hospitality.
